



Notes for Team Captains

In previous years there have been a number of problems when Team Captains failed to meet their organisational expectations. This resulted in Organisers not being able to pay all their bills and in one case the Match Organiser was out of pocket (the Association paid him and collected the money afterwards). **These notes are to help make sure that everyone knows what is required of them.**

Before the Match

If any member of your team is NOT going to stay for the meal after the match you MUST let the Organiser know TWO DAYS before the match. The days when caterer's shrugged their shoulders, and just asked to be paid for the number who had eaten are long gone. Caterer's now insist on being paid for the number of meals booked. Your Club should have pre-paid for the boats but your anglers will have to buy their own fishing ticket.

On arrival

Give the Match Organiser your Captains Card with your team names in the order you want them to appear on the score sheet and pay the organiser for the meals (in cash). This will probably be £8.00 per head in 2006.

After the Match

If there is a problem then you and the other Captains have to sort it out. The score sheet MUST be completed and a result announced. A report then goes to the Committee for a final decision.
